Process

1. **Application** – Candidate will send:
 1. Application Form
 2. Resume in word format in English
 3. Copy of candidate's passport
 4. Skype ID
2. **Skype Admittance Consultation** – The applicant will speak with one of our placement specialist to discuss their interests, motivation in joining the program as well as verify their English level.
3. **Program Registration** – In order to fully register in the program, candidates must fully pay the program fee. No sponsor letter or job placement will be provided without registration.
4. **Job Placement:** Once the participant is registered, the job placement process will begin until a job offer is confirmed.
5. **Visa Application** – Once a job has been secured, we will assist the applicant in applying for the employer specific work permit.

Important: Avoiding Delays in your Work Permit Process! Police Certificate from each country or territory where you have lived for six consecutive months or longer since reaching the age of 18 might be required. This can take time, but you can avoid delays by getting it done early.

6. **Arrival in Canada** – Before arrival in Canada, the participant will receive welcome documents and support to help them with obtaining social insurance number, opening bank account, cell phone, transportation to the job location etc. so it is very easy for them to kick start their program in Canada.
7. **Monitoring Process** – Our placement coordinator will monitor the candidate on a

Refund Policy

- Refund 100% Program Fee if candidate fails visa. In most of the case, if candidate provide us with most accurate information and background, the visa application will certainly pass through.
